



1. Tell students they will be taking notes as they go through the Earl Scruggs Center and use these notes to create an informational poster when they return.
2. Give students the Gallery Walk Poster Planning sheet for one, two or all three sections of the center.
3. Instruct students to describe each section as they are walking through and record any interesting facts they discover. Remind students that there is a section for illustrations and graphics so that they may draw interesting things they see also.
4. Back at school allow students time to design, create and share their posters either through a presentation or by displaying them and allowing students to look over them all.
