Our galleries are filled with **interactive, multi-sensory components** that ignite curiosity. Learners can use headphones to listen to oral histories, instruments or radio shows, or engage with our state-of-the-art Common Threads touch screen table.

Sizes, Shapes, Colors

Grade level: K-2nd grades

This program is specially designed for our younger visitors. After a warm welcome by our staff, educators will be given our Seek & Find Flipbooks; these flipbooks enable educators to "tour" learners through our exhibits, asking them to hunt for artifacts of all different sizes, shapes and colors. Pictures, questions and answers are all contained in the flipbooks for easy use by educators. This program also includes our banjo petting zoo where students can touch, hear and pick our banjos.

Grade level: 2nd and up

Civil War On Tour Trunk

Using music, artifacts, letters, articles, maps and more, students will not just learn about, but discover, various perspectives during the Civil War. Students use primary, secondary and tertiary sources to draw conclusions about slavery, women, technology, battles and espionage during this time of crisis in the United States. This trunk is designed with an emphasis on North Carolina and contains lesson plans for 5 days.
