

- 1. Tell students they will be taking notes as they go through the Earl Scruggs Center and use these notes to create an informational poster when they return.
- 2. Give students the Gallery Walk Poster Planning sheet for one, two or all three sections of the center.
- 3. Instruct students to describe each section as they are walking through and record any interesting facts they discover. Remind students that there is a section for illustrations and graphics so that they may draw interesting things they see also.
- 4. Back at school allow students time to design, create and share their posters either through a presentation or by displaying them and allowing students to look over them all.
